Ár bhFís Our Vision

Pobal bríomhar, muiníneach Gaeltachta a chaomhnú agus a chothú sa cheantar agus líon na gcainteoirí laethúla Gaeilge sa Limistéar Pleanála Teanga a mhéadú 20% faoin mbliain 2025. Labhairt na Gaeilge a normalú i measc daoine óga sa cheantar le cinntiú go gcuirfear í ar aghaidh ag an gcéad ghlúin eile mar theanga pobail.

The protection and promotion of the area's vibrant, confident Gaeltacht community and a 20% increase in the number of daily Irish speakers in the Language Planning Area by 2025. Normalise the use of Irish among young people in the area to ensure it is passed on to the next generation as a community language.

The area's Gaeltacht status depends on this work.

Irish has been spoken in Dúiche Sheoigheach and Tuar Mhic Éadaigh for generations – we have an opportunity now to ensure its future as a community language in the area.
